ACADEMICS

We are proud to report that the 2021-22 batch of X std students have brought laurels to the school by their excellent results. We had 26 distinctions and 80% first classes.

Kavya V K was the topper with a percentage of 98.8% aggregate.

This was possible because of the continuous efforts by the dedicated staff and by taking extra classes and other remedial measures to improve them.

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES:

A host of co-curricular activities have been organised during the year. To promote the competitive spirit and to bring out the talent of the students. They are encouraged to participate in various activities. Competitions like Essay, Collage , Drawing, Painting , Pencil Sketch, Fancy Dress, Singing , Speech, Best out of Waste were conducted during the course of the year. Participation by the students and teachers in these events was very commendable.

Students also participated in Prathibha Karanji which is a cluster level competition and won several prizes.

The school has many students who not only excel in academics but also in the area of Dance, Music, Theatre and Art. A lot of them have already performed on stage to the outside world, thus making an interesting career out of these areas.

As a new initiative , every Saturday we are conducting various activities like clay modelling, embroidery , bottle painting, Card Making etc apart from academics for LKG to Class 8 to promote holistic development of the students.

ENVIRONMENT DAY was celebrated on 5th JUNE to create awareness and instill a sense of responsibility towards conserving the environment. The theme was 'ONLY ONE EARTH'. Students

also planted saplings and many of our students participated in drawing, painting, pencil sketch and collage competitions at school level.

YOGA:

This year, we also focused on Yoga classes to maintain overall physical, mental and emotional well being of the students. Students were taught various coping strategies like pranayama, asanas etc. we also celebrated International Yoga Day to spread awareness about the importance and holistic health benefits of Yoga.

MORAL EDUCATION:
